## 2024-2025 ACADEMIC YEAR SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

### Submission Deadline: February 16, 2024

Under the oversight of ACEC Metropolitan Washington's Past Presidents Committee, ACEC/MW will award four (4) separate General Student Scholarships in the amount of \$4,000 each.

### Eligibility

- Students must be entering their junior, senior, fifth, or master's degree year in the fall of 2024 to qualify for the general scholarships.
- The student must be a U.S. citizen pursuing a Bachelor's or Master's degree in engineering or in an accredited land-surveying program.
- The student must be connected to the Washington, DC Metropolitan area through either:
  - A home address within the Washington, DC Metropolitan Area, OR
  - Attendance at an eligible DC area University.
